I. Call to Order

NSTC Liaison Dr. Gene Whitney called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

II. Approval of Minutes and Review of Actions

Members approved the November meeting minutes.

III. Summary of Discussion

A. Report from the NSTC Liaison

Dr. Whitney began the meeting by describing the SDR re-vetting process and welcoming the new agency representatives. He also described the SDR Working Groups and ongoing work with the Grand Challenges implementation plans.

The Tsunami Lessons Learned and U.S. National Tsunami Plan have both been cleared, and will be posted to the SDR website very soon.

Dr. Whitney also mentioned that the WindHRP report is ready to be submitted to Congress, and will be posted to the SDR website after it is transmitted to Congress.

On 17 November, Dr. Whitney, Dr. David Applegate and Mr. John Gaynor met with members of the National Science Board (NSB) about their intention to summarize current activities in hurricane-related science and engineering research, identify gaps and opportunities and recommend priorities for action. The NSB is seeking input from the SDR and will brief SDR members on their activities at the January meeting.

B. Briefing and Discussion – Federal Emergency Management Agency

Mr. Fred Sharrocks of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) briefed the SDR on FEMA's work during the 2005 hurricane season. Mr. Sharrocks also described some of FEMA's ongoing work within the Mitigation Division, including the National Flood Insurance Program, Flood Map Modernization Program and the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program.

Mr. Sharrocks' presentation and handouts will be posted on the Members Only page of the SDR website.

IV. Working Group Reports

Grand Challenges Task Group. Dr. Noel Raufaste discussed the ongoing Grand Challenges implementation strategy four-page documents. The Drought, Coastal Inundation, Wind Hazards, Hurricane, Tornado and Severe Weather, Winter Storms and Heat Wave documents have been finalized. They are being graphically-designed and will be posted on the SDR Members Only website on Tuesday, 6 December for Member comments prior to initiating SDR clearance on 9 December. The Tsunami, Wildland Fire, Earthquake, Flood, Human and Ecosystem Health Hazards, Technological, Landslides and Debris Flow and Volcano documents are due to the Secretariat on 16 December and will enter the SDR clearance process in January.

A Grand Challenges offsite will be organized for March/April. Dr. Whitney encouraged Members to be more creative in their outreach with the Grand Challenges documents and suggested this be discussed at the January meeting. Possibilities include stakeholder workshops or hazard-specific events.

WindHRP Working Group. The WindHRP document is complete and has been cleared by the White House. OSTP must now transmit the report to Congress.

Earth Observations Working Group. Mr. Steven Ambrose stated that agencies must send their clearance forms for the 24-hour Waiver Recommendation to the Secretariat by 5:00 p.m. EST on Friday, 2 December. The Working Group will hold its next meeting during the first week in January.

Mr. Steve Clark asked if anyone in the Working Group would be present at next week's Defense Intelligence Agency meeting and said he would send information to Dr. Whitney about the event.

International Working Group. Dr. Fernando Echavarria recently attended the World Summit on the Information Society in Tunis and showcased the SDR during his presentation. He recommended all Members view the recording of the statement given by Dr. John H. Marburger, III, Director, White House Office of Science and Technology Policy online at www.itu.org.

V. Close and Next Actions

Mr. Ralph Cantral reported that he and Dr. Margaret Davidson co-chaired a coastal breakout group during the Climate Science and decision-makers workshop and encouraged all Members to log onto www.climatescience.gov to read more about this successful event.
