



Nuclear Regulatory Commission Overview


- NRC established by the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974
- License and regulate the nation's civilian use of byproduct, source and special nuclear materials to ensure adequate protection of public health and safety, promote the common defense and security, and protect the environment.
- Practically everything the NRC does is related to prevention and mitigation of disasters.
- Most of our budget is related to nuclear power plants, but we are also responsible for the entire nuclear fuel cycle and the civilian uses of other nuclear materials including radioactive sources.
- The NRC employs nearly 4,000 people between HQ in Rockville and four regional offices
- Annual budget of about \$1 billion; 90% of budget is recovered from licensees
- Budget is expected to be flat for foreseeable future.
